



THEFT FROM VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

Make sure you secure your vehicle before leaving it unattended.

Lock all doors and close windows.

Do not leave valuables unattended or in plain sight in your vehicle.

Avoid transferring items into your trunk in view of other people prior to leaving your vehicle unattended.

Do not park vehicle in secluded areas.


Always park your vehicle in lighted areas at night.

Be aware of your surroundings for suspicious persons or activities.

If you return to your car and find someone suspicious inside or near it,

DO NOT APPROACH. CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY

Stay Calm

Carefully observe the suspect.

Pay particular attention to distinguishing features such as marks, scars, tattoos, or a limp. Start from head and work down.

Write down what you saw as soon as possible after the incident.

Which direction suspect left the area.

How suspect left the area, car, bike, ran or walked.

Is there more than one suspect?

Use all of your senses: sight, sound, feel, smell, and taste.

Take note if there are **ANY WEAPONS**.
