HAZARDOUS DUTY PAY

POLICY

Employees of the Honolulu Police Department shall be guided by this directive in determining and claiming hazardous duty pay.

PROCEDURE

I. REQUIREMENT

- A. All hazardous duty as defined by collective bargaining contracts and/or approved by the Director of Human Resources shall be reported on the Hazardous Duty Pay, HPD-432 form.
- B. The hazardous duty assignments of helicopter pilots and observers and motorcycle personnel do not need to be reported on the Hazardous Duty Pay, HPD-432 form.

II. PROCEDURES

- A. All information requested on the form must be typed or printed legibly with a black ballpoint pen.
- B. The completed form shall be submitted to the appropriate element commander for approval.

C. If approved, the information shall be posted to the appropriate timekeeping record.
