#### PARKING COMPLAINTS RELATED TO SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS

#### POLICY

The Honolulu Police Department considers pedestrian safety and the availability of parking in residential neighborhoods when addressing parking complaints in accordance with applicable laws and departmental directives.

#### PROCEDURE

I. PAVED SIDEWALK AREA

Enforcement action shall be taken when vehicles are parked on:

- A. Paved sidewalks; or
- B. The grass strip between the street curb and paved sidewalk.

### II. UNPAVED SIDEWALK AREAS

In addressing vehicles that are parked on unpaved sidewalks, officers shall consider whether:

- A. There is sufficient clearance for a pedestrian and/or wheelchair to safely pass through without having to enter the roadway;
- B. Vehicles are parked parallel to the roadway;
- C. Vehicles are completely off the roadway; and/or
- D. Vehicles create a safety hazard not mentioned above.

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### III. PARKING WITHIN FOUR FEET OF DRIVEWAY

The Traffic Code authorizes, but does not mandate, the police to remove and store vehicles that are parked within four feet of a driveway. However, citations shall be issued for all violations, and a vehicle that encroaches upon a driveway area and impedes the ingress and egress shall be towed.
