TRAINING PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY THE TRAINING DIVISION

POLICY

The Training Division shall administer the recruit training program and other training programs as designated by the department.

PROCEDURE

I. OBJECTIVES

- A. To provide instruction in current police practices and related subjects.
- B. To provide training to help departmental personnel develop:
 - 1. Appropriate habits of thought and action;
 - 2. Skills:
 - 3. Knowledge; and
 - 4. An attitude to be effective in their assignments and cooperate among themselves to fulfill departmental goals.
- C. To train personnel to enable them to efficiently serve the public.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES

A. Chief of Police

Training will be conducted under the direction of the Chief of Police who may:

- 1. Determine the curriculum and direct recruit training;
- Direct advanced training or recall training for departmental employees;
- 3. Maintain training records of all personnel; and
- 4. Require that the examination results of each course be made a part of a probationary or regular employee's training record.

B. Training Division Commander

The Training Division commander shall ensure that:

- All regular training schedules are prepared and affected personnel are notified on a timely basis;
- 2. Special training projects do not conflict with established training schedules and procedures; and
- 3. All required training is conducted as a result of laws, statutes, and/or authorized departmental programs (i.e., annual - use of force and sexual harassment; biennial - ethics training).

C. Element Commanders

Element commanders or designees shall:

- 1. Analyze the training needs in their elements;
- 2. Submit requests for specialized training as required to the Training Division through appropriate channels; and
- 3. Train element personnel in normal operational and work procedures.

III. OTHER TRAINING

Other elements may administer training as designated by the department.
