

Pedestrian Safety



WALK SIGNAL IS STEADY

Start crossing when this signal appears. This is the only time you may enter a crosswalk.



RED HAND IS FLASHING

Don't start crossing if this signal appears. Finish crossing if it appears and you are already in the crosswalk.



RED HAND IS STEADY

Remain at the curb when this signal appears. Push the pedestrian button and wait for the walk signal.



RED HAND WITH NUMBERS

Don't start crossing if this signal appears. Finish crossing within the time allowed.

The Law

Pedestrian Violations:

HRS 291C-33(2):

Pedestrian obedience to "Don't Walk" or flashing signal

Penalties:

Fine: \$130

HRS 291C-73(c):

Jaywalking

Fine: \$130

ROH 15-24.23: (Eff. 10/25/2017)

No pedestrian shall cross a street or highway while **VIEWING** a mobile electronic device

Fine: \$15 - \$99


Crossing Safely

- ALWAYS use a marked crosswalk
- Make eye contact, look left, right, and left again
- Wear white, bright, or reflective clothing


STOP FOR PEDESTRIANS



STOP until the pedestrian has safely passed in front of you

HRS 291C-72(a)(1):
Vehicle to stop/yield right-of-way to pedestrian in crosswalk upon same half of roadway.


Fine: Court



STOP when a pedestrian is approaching from the other side of the road

HRS 291C-72(a)(2):
Vehicle to stop for pedestrian in crosswalk approaching from other half of the roadway.

Fine: Court



STOP behind a car that is waiting for a pedestrian

HRS 291C-72(d):
No overtaking of another vehicle stopped for pedestrian at the intersection.

Fine: Court
